- 1 **Chardonnay, Alta Baliza, 2016/17, Central Valley, Chile**
Fresh and young, slightly golden with green olive hints. Sweet, tropical aromas such as banana and pineapple combine and on the palate, the wine is crisp, soft and well-balanced. (2) 12.5% vol

- 2 **Sauvignon Blanc, Santa Helena, 2016/17, Central Valley, Chile**
This classic Chilean style of Sauvignon Blanc is lively and lifted, with a herbal green pea leafiness and real freshness through the finish. (2) 12% vol

- 3 **Pinot Grigio, Laroma, Botter, 2016/17, Venetie, Italy**
Fresh, dry and delicate with gentle floral and citrus aromas. A classic Italian white wine. (2) 12% vol

This is an outstanding wine that really delivers. Fresh with a bright aroma of white flowers and zesty citrus. (1) 13% vol

- 12 **Tempranillo, Esencia de Fontana, 2015/16, Uclés, Spain**
Intense aromas of ripe berry fruit and liquorice. Medium-bodied with beautiful balance between fruit concentration, fresh acidity and fine tannins. (B) 13.5% vol

- 13 **Cabernet Sauvignon, Alta Baliza, 2015/16, Central Valley, Chile**
Attractive aromas of berries with mature red fruits and spices. The palate demonstrates the classical force of the variety, with a firm body and lasting finish. (C) 13% vol

- 14 **Merlot Reserva, Villa Rosaura, 2015/16, Central Valley, Chile**
A deep violet red wine with mature red fruit aromas of plum combined with spiced notes. On the palate, rich, velvety tannins, a medium body and a lasting finish. (C) 13% vol

- 15 **Shiraz, Rumours, 2016/17, South East Australia**

Rich, full-bodied but very smooth with delicious intense fruit and a complex, elegant finish. (D) 13% vol

Fully ripe, intense and glossy. It is bright and silky with vibrant hedgerow fruits and layers of subtle berry and spice flavours. (C) 13% vol

- 18 **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Nicodemi Terrana, 2015/16, Abruzzo, Italy**
A broody, unfiltered wine with real depth and intensity yet it's designed to be drunk young. Sweet dark fruits and smoky notes combine to deliver a long lingering finish. (C) 13% vol

- 19 **Fleurie, Château de L'Abbaye, 2014/15, Beaujolais, France**
Beautifully floral as the name would suggest with notes of iris, violet, rose and peach. An elegant wine with smooth tannins, a classic from the Gamay grape. (B) 12.5% vol

- 20 **Chianti Classico, Castello d'Albola, 2013/14, Italy**
A traditional Chianti Classico with aromas of fruit cake and subtle spice and a complex yet balanced palate with herbal undertones. (D) 13% vol

This wine's bouquet charms with scents of red cherry, ripe strawberry, cola and spice. On the palate, soft mouthfeel complements flavours recalling plums and black cherry. Supple tannins and a dash of acidity end in a beautifully balanced, clean finish. (C) 14.5% vol
